By signing this agreement, you're expressing an interest to join the Youth Psychosocial Support Packages (YPSP) Program. This program aims to help you, whether you live independently or with your family, to become involved in social, economic, and community activities.

As part of this agreement, you will need to commit to:

- Being ready and wanting to live in your own home with drop-in supports from your chosen community managed organisation.
- Respecting your own health, safety and welfare, and that of others.
- Starting to participate in the community and building relationships.
- Participating in recovery-oriented supports that work towards achieving your recovery aims.

The YPSP offers financial assistance to help you live independently, create social connections, and engage with your community. However, it is important to note that this funding cannot be utilised for covering everyday living costs like rent and household bills.

To ensure successful recovery and participation in the community, it's crucial that you acknowledge and actively participate in the supports and conditions mentioned above, as they define the purpose of the YPSP program.
